

**\* \* NOTICE OF FEE INCREASES \* \***

The Wyoming Board of Professional Geologists has been able to hold fees constant for the past five years through careful monitoring of expenses and the use of funds held in reserve.

After careful review and discussion, the Board recognizes that the negative effect of the accumulating increases in state mandated administrative costs and other costs beyond the Board's control (postage, utilities, etc.) combined with the continuing attrition in the number of licensees (approximately 2% per year) can no longer be absorbed. Increases in fees are necessary at this time in order to keep services and technology current.
