WYOMING BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL GEOLOGISTS WELCOMES THREE NEW BOARD MEMBERS

Three new Board members, **J. Joel Farber**, **W. Todd Jarvis**, and **Lynn A. Sessions**, were recently appointed by Governor Geringer to serve terms through June, 2001. A short introduction to each new member is provided below:

■ J. Joel Farber ■

Mr. Farber is a consulting engineer and geologist with Banner Associates, Inc. in Laramie. He received a B.S. degree in Geology in 1981, a B.S. in Civil Engineering in 1988, and an M.S. in Civil Engineering/Water Resources in 1992, all from the University of Wyoming. He is licensed as a Professional Geologist in Wyoming (PG- 1462). His work experience includes five years as an exploration geologist in the oil & gas industry. For the last ten years, he has worked principally on a variety of water resources projects throughout Wyoming. He performs geologic investigations pertaining to civil and environmental engineering projects. He also conducts water rights investigations, flood studies, water supply and yield analyses, and hydraulic designs. His professional practice now encompasses work in the fields of geology, hydrology, and hydraulics. He is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers and the Wyoming Engineering Society. His activities within his community include coaching little league in the Laramie Youth Baseball program. He enjoys fly fishing, hunting, and cross-country skiing.

■ W. Todd Jarvis ■

Mr. Jarvis is the Supervising Hydrogeologist and Manager of the Laramie branch office of Weston Engineering, Inc., a Wyoming-based firm specializing in well drilling, rehabilitation, groundwater resource development, and groundwater protection. He received a B.S. in Geology with emphasis in Engineering and Economic Geology in 1983 and an M.S. in Geology with emphasis in Hydrogeology in 1986, both from the University of Wyoming. His work experience includes several years in both the petroleum and the consulting engineering industries working on projects located across the United States and abroad. He is licensed as a Professional Geologist in Wyoming (PG-25), Idaho, and Oregon and he is a Certified Engineering Geologist in Oregon. He is also a Certified Ground Water Professional by the National Groundwater Association. He regularly lectures at the University of Wyoming's Departments of Geology and Civil Engineering, and is a common guest speaker to Rocky Mountain and Intermountain professional organizations on topics in engineering geology and groundwater protection. He regularly serves as a "Shadow" for the career development program at the Laramie High School. He enjoys studying water law, dam history, white water rafting, and collecting cattle dogs.

■ Lynn A. Sessions ■

Ms. Sessions is a Geologist/Mining Engineer with Pittsburg & Midway Coal Mining Company in Kemmerer. She is responsible for mine geology including collecting raw data (planning & supervising drilling operations) and computer modeling of coal seams, as well as long and short-term mine planning. She received a B.S. degree in Geology in 1980 and a B.S. degree in Secondary Science Education in 1990, both from the University of Wyoming. Her work experience includes several years as a consulting and staff geologist in oil & gas exploration for various companies in the Powder River Basin. She is licensed in Wyoming as a Professional Geologist (PG-539). She is also a member of the Wyoming Geological Association and the Rocky Mountain Association of Geologists. She has served as a field trip leader for the Wyoming Geological Association and as teacher/trainer for minewide (300+ employees) Continuous Improvement (TQM) seminars. She stays very active within her community, participating in the local elementary and middle school science fair as a speaker, supporting recreational activities for youth in the summer months, as well as supporting local senior citizens' and women's crisis centers. She enjoys hunting and fishing, horseback riding and camping in the mountains, reading, and skiing.
